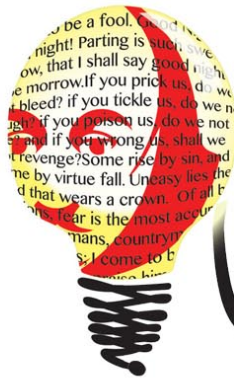

# Write On!

**Write On!**, is a 8-week in-person employment program that hires L.A. youth ages 15-24. Youth are hired to produce and perform their own creative writing inspired by William Shakespeare's poetry and informed by conversations about social justice issues in today's world. Meeting Saturdays in person, twice a week after-school online and completing independent work assignments, participants will engage in group discussions, practice performance techniques, explore Shakespeare's works (with an emphasis on Romeo & Juliet), and study dramatic writing. A wrap-up event will feature presentations by all participants.

## Program Requirement:

An interest in writing, a willingness to discuss topics of importance to you, and an openness to listen and learn from our community.

### All applicants are required to:

- Apply through the **HIRE LA's YOUTH** program
- Submit employment application
- Submit **ALL** necessary documents

Applications without all proper documentation will be added to the waiting list. Once you have submitted all necessary documents a representative from SCLA will call you to schedule next steps.
